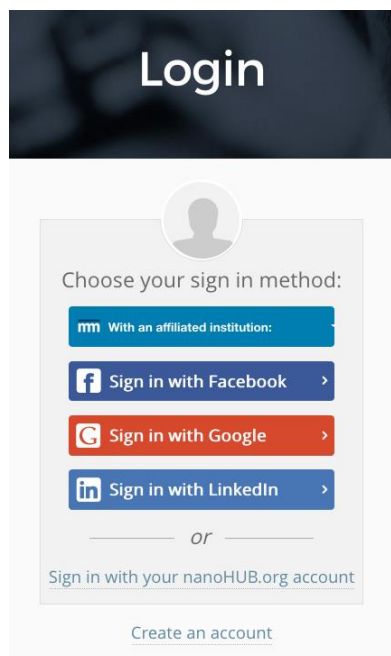


Getting Started on nanoHUB for Summer Undergraduate Research Symposium

Step 1: Log in to your nanoHUB account or create an account if you do not yet have one. You need to have an account in order to access your personal nanoHUB dashboard, join a group or run simulations. Go to <https://www.nanoHUB.org> and sign in or create a new account.



If you are affiliated with Purdue, use your **institutional email** account. You can also use your **Facebook**, **Google** or **LinkedIn** account or create an account by using any email address.

Important: If you create an account using your email address, you must respond to the confirmation email that will be sent to the email address associated with your sign-in method to complete the registration process.

If you have a nanoHUB account and have forgotten your password, click on the forgotten password link. If you need more help, click on the “need help” link in the top right corner of the nanoHUB page to ask for help in accessing your account.

Step 2: Join the group: https://nanohub.org/groups/purdue_surp2020

- You must be logged in, then click the button on the left to request group membership.
- **Please include in the description your affiliation with Purdue or the presenters. Those without Purdue email addresses and no descriptions will be delayed acceptance into the group.**

- Give at least 24 hours for your membership to be approved.
